Design for Manufacturing Innovation Grant

Employees of Rhode Island manufacturers with annual sales of 10% or greater to the Department of Defense may qualify for one of two different Design Thinking certificate of training programs under a DoD grant.

One is through <u>Bryant University</u> and the other through <u>RI School of Design (RISD)</u>. Both programs will recommence in October 2017 and the tuition rates for each of the Design Thinking programs are listed on their respective web links. The DoD grant will reimburse participating students who work for qualifying RI manufacturing employers. Visit the web links above for more information on either program.

Disaster Response Contracting

In the aftermath of a disaster, potential contractors swarm to the site hoping for a piece of the clean-up and recovery effort. For inexperienced players, it can be chaotic, confusing, and cut-throat, as informal subcontracting agreements, which may not be enforceable, are made on the ground. Sometimes third-party firms falsely promise no-bid contracts to those who pay to be on a "priority vendors list" (there is no such list).
