FAR Council Publishes Update to Small Business Subcontracting Regulations

SBA Proposes Rule to Use 24-Month Period to Calculate

Number of Employees

The SBA has proposed a rule that would use a 24-month period when calculating a companies number of employees. The preceding rule took the average number of employees from each pay period in the last 12 months. This proposed rule effectively doubles this length of time. This new rule could make businesses smaller or larger depending on different situations.
