New Proposed Rule Seeks to Implement Accelerated Payments to Small Business Contractors Across the Government

The FAR council has issued a proposed rule that could potentially speed up payments to small business contractors. This new rule seeks to incentivize agencies to pay small businesses within 15 days. This proposed rule will apply to commercial contracts as well those under the the simplified acquisition threshold.

DOD Construction: House-Passed 2022 NDAA Establishes

Preferences for Local Contractors

Department of Defense contracts under the new 2022 National Defense Authorization Act will have preferences for local construction companies. The house agreed to an amendment that requires, to the extent practicable, the DOD to give preference to construction companies that hire local employees.

It also requires contractors and subcontractors on military construction contracts to be licensed in the state where the work in being performed.

House-Passed 2022 NDAA Raises Sole Source Thresholds for 8(a), SDVOSB, HUBZone, and WOSB/EDWOSB Contracts

The National Defense Authorization Act would increase sole source thresholds for socioeconomic preference programs. An amendment to the House version of the 2022 NDAA includes an amendment that would raise the sole source caps for contracts awarded to qualified 8(a) Program participants, service-disabled veteran-owned small businesses, HUBZone Program participants, and woman-owned small businesses.
